1951 saw the opening of the Royal Festival Hall situated on the South Bank of London's River Thames as part of the Festival of Britain.

This fantastic building has just re-opened after undergoing a two year - £91 million refurbishment.

Besides being a world leading performance venue, the building proudly boasts a Ballroom, South Bank Centre Shop, a number of places to eat and drink, as well as The Saison Poetry Library. This houses the Arts Council poetry collection, the most comprehensive and accessible collection of modern poetry in Britain.

As part of this extensive refurbishment Mann McGowan's Firestile® fully glazed fire resisting doors have been installed in various public areas around the building including six doors that form a fire barrier to the entrance to the library, The Sunley Pavilion and the Westminster Roof Pavilion.

The doors were fitted with Jatoba glazing beads, some of which were French Polished at the client's request. All the doors were glazed with 6mm Pyran Fire Resisting Glass using Pyroglaze® glazing seals.
